Best Paper Submissions

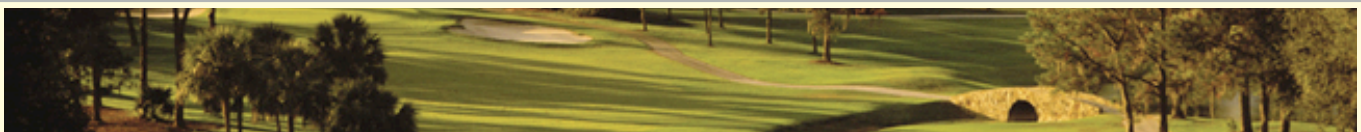
